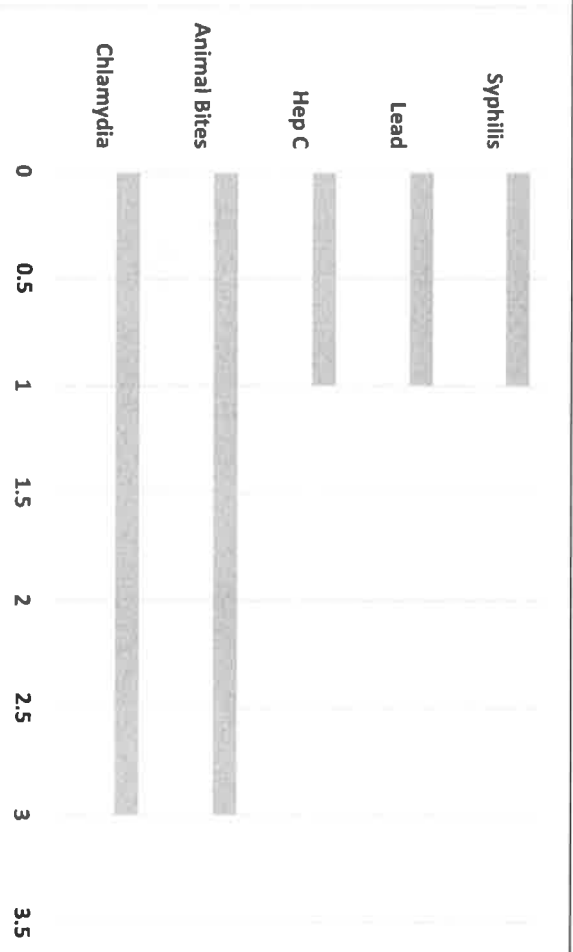

Tobacco Prevention	City Council approved tobacco free parks for the City of Glendive. Lindsay is working with Jack Rice to determine the number of signs needed. Montana's emergency rules temporarily restrict the sale of all flavored vaping products	

	<p>(other than tobacco and marijuana flavor), including the flavor of menthol. The emergency rules apply to both closed (i.e. pre-filled cartridge or pod-based systems) and open systems (mixable). Montana's emergency rules are in effect till April 15, 2020.</p> <p>The FDA guidance (announced, but not yet in effect until 2/6/2020) prioritizes enforcement against closed cartridge/pod based flavored vaping products (e.g., Juul's). Enforcement will apply to all flavors in these closed systems except for tobacco and menthol flavors. Flavoring sold in open vaping systems (e.g., tanks and mods) are not prioritized under the FDA guidance and, therefore, not likely to be subject to enforcement</p> <p>Under the new federal law, the minimum age to purchase tobacco products is now 21. Under state law, the minimum age to purchase tobacco products currently remains at age 18. Selling a tobacco product to a person who is 18 years of age complies with the current state law. However, such a sale violates federal law and would subject the retailer to penalties under the federal law. Montana law does not alter the federal law requirements. In order to comply with federal law, a retailer cannot sell tobacco products to persons under the age of 21.</p>

There were calls to the Sanitarian and the Health Department the City's water was bad before there was any notification from the source.</p> <p>City of the Glendive- Mary Jo received a grant for a power lift for the 4th ambulance. Ambulance numbers for 2019 were down to about 660. EMT classes have 4 students left and should finish up in February and March.</p> <p>GMC- Behavioral health inpatient is up and running with 3-4 beds. The remodeling has been completed for PT and OT, the new space is located in the clinic where the pharmacy was.</p>
