<p><b>New Business:</b></p> <p>COVID-19</p>	<p>A motion was made by Commissioner Jerry to approve meeting minutes as published, from 5/22/2020. Seconded by Brett. Motion carried, all in favor, none opposed.</p> <p>Update: Montana has had 14 new cases in the past week bringing the total to 493 cases. Currently there are 28 active cases.</p> <p>The Governor's Phase 2 Guidance updated information.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If over 50 are expected they would need to work with local public health to ensure social distancing and other safety protocols could be achieved. If they can't achieve that, then events over 50 should be cancelled. Local authorities would still have the ability to limit events.</li> <li>• concessions follow restaurant and sanitation protocols where applicable.</li> <li>• Groups larger than 50 people should be cancelled unless physical distancing can be maintained.</li> <li>• Consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) guidelines, event cutoff threshold is at the discretion of community leadership based on current circumstances in your community.</li> <li>• Physical distancing guidelines for groups and gatherings do not apply to household members.</li> </ul>	

Event Requests:

**DCC High School Basketball Tournament  
And Officiating Camp  
June 19-21, 2020**

- Will only hold the tournament if Montana is in Phase 2 of reopening
- We will have hand sanitizer available for everyone at several stations
- Facilities will clean and disinfect used areas on a regular basis
- Limit teams to 24 teams- 12 girls and 12 boys (we usually have 35-50)
- No teams from out of state will be allowed if 14-day self-quarantine for out of state people is still in effect- unless given permission by County Health Dept
- We would only use the Toepke Center and no other facilities (we usually use high school and middle school)
- Fans would be limited to 200 in building at a time- our upstairs viewing capacity is 896 so this would be ¼ of full occupancy
- No concessions will be served
- Limit referees in camp to the first 24 who register
- Referees will only come from the state of Montana
- Referees will use Toepke Auditorium so that they have room to be spread apart

Jerry motioned to approve the DCC tournament as outlined by Joe Peterson with suggested improvements. Seconded by Cindy.

- Traffic flow could be controlled better such as using one set of stairs going up and the other to exit, and have specific doors to enter and another to exit.
- Allow more time between games so social distancing is easier to follow.

Discussion:

Teams coming from a county with active cases would not be able to participate.

With contract tracing in place, having cases in a county shouldn't as much of a concern because as soon as a case is identified public health investigates to identify close contacts and implement quarantine measures.

Traffic flow could be controlled better such as using one set of stairs going up and the other to exit, and have specific doors to enter and another to exit.

Allow more time between games so social distancing is easier to follow.

Mary Jo has hand sanitizer available, to be used for government and non-profit entities.

The City of Glendive has installed hand sanitizer dispensers and will be utilizing the supply of hand sanitizer available from DES. The swimming pool will open during Phase 2, swim lessons will begin around June 8<sup>th</sup>.
