Mayor Jimison stated that he along with the county commissioners attended a MDT presentation on Highway funding for District 5. They reviewed projects over the next 5 years. The City and County qualify for Urban Transportation funding. The city and county can designate roads and city streets for this special district. Also if agreed upon, they may be eligible to apply for capital improvement funding. Meade Avenue was agreed upon as the designated street and the State Highway would do entire Meade Avenue after the county puts their force main in, which is slated for 2019. Dawson County and Glendive would be eligible for Urban Preservation funds of \$300,000 to \$600,000 every 3 years on designated routes in the Urban District. They are lacking county designated routes. Pine Street, Jefferson School Road and Highland Park Road are eligible, but need to be assessed. He would like to suggest that road supervisor, Joe Sharbono and city public works director Rice do evaluations and submit them to the state so we can get a route designated and be eligible for the funding.

Tom Christensen-Mr. Christensen asked when the Forest Park Zoning and Planning Commission meeting was rescheduled to. He was informed that it has been rescheduled for March 28th, at 5:30 p.m. in the courtroom. He also stated that he has questions on the sewer system. He asked in regards to the progress on easements. He was told that they are in progress. They had a difficult getting anyone to return their phone calls from Albertsons, but they have

eventually made a contact and they are in the process and they are doing radar detection on a possible old buried tank from a gas station. They are working to reach an agreement with Crisafulli property. They would like to be able to go to bid in June. He asked what the plans are for the old lagoon? Commissioner Buxbaum stated they have suggested that they would like to keep one cell open as a place they could go to in the case of an emergency if they had to shut down the plant. Great West Engineering is looking into it, to see if they will be able to do this or not. He asked if the sewage plant was part city and part county? He was informed it was funded based on the flow rate and it was about 70% city and 30% county. He inquired about the route that they were going to go from the lagoon to the city connection. Commissioner Gartner was showing him the route on a map that Mr. Christensen had. He stated he was welcome to get a copy of the map the commissioners had with the route laid out on it. He asked if the commissioners were aware of an opinion by the attorney general that once that area had sewer connection that it could be annexed to the city? Commissioner Gartner stated that in order to be annexed the city would require a petition. He stated that he believes that they need to look at annexing it. The commissioners stated that would be a city issue in regards to annexing it, it would be out of the commissioner control. It should be addressed to the city council. He also stated that the county would not be maintaining the lagoon cell, it would simply remain there as a backup for an emergency situation if they find out they can do this.

The meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
