Date, Time, and Place:

The Dawson County Track and Field Day is scheduled for Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at Perm Field (Dawson County High School) in Glendive. Students in grades 4-8 who plan on running in the mile should arrive by 8:30 and be ready to run by 8:40. Students in grades K-3 who plan on running in the 400 should arrive by 8:45 and be ready to run by 8:55. All other students should arrive between 8:30 – 8:50 and be ready for your events to begin at approximately 9:00.

Teachers, parents, and other volunteers working the track meet events should arrive by 8:15 and report to their events. The track meet will end at the conclusion of the last event, which is anticipated to be about 12:00 p.m. Afternoon activities are the responsibility of each school.

Signup Sheets:

Each participant may sign up for no more than five (5) track and field events. Please return all forms to the county superintendent's office ASAP, but no later than **5:00 p.m. Wednesday, April 23. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Each child should have a separate signup sheet. Each school should submit one sheet for relay teams. Signup sheets may be returned via mail, email, fax, or dropped off at the superintendent's office in the courthouse.

Relay Teams:

Each school is allowed one (1) K-3 relay team and one (1) 4-8 relay team. However, if schools do not have enough athletes to form teams, then two or more schools may join together to form teams, as long as each school only has participants on one team in each race. Students in grades K-3 may be on 4-8 teams if a school does not have enough athletes in grades 4-8 to form a team, but students in grades 4-8 may NOT be on K-3 teams.

Volunteers:

Our track meet is staffed entirely by teachers, parents, and other volunteers. We appreciate the time and hard work every one of our volunteers dedicates to making our track meet a success. If you would like to volunteer, please complete the volunteer portion of the student signup sheet.

Important Information:

Lunch is the responsibility of each school district. Parents are usually responsible for their own child(ren) at lunchtime and the teachers have lunch on their own.

Water, sunscreen, and snacks are the responsibility of the parents. All parents should send or bring these items with them.

A Dawson County School Nurse will be available with a first aid kit during the meet.

Please observe the following rules during the meet:

- **No one may be on the track or field except athletes who are participating in events and volunteers who are working the events. Anyone interfering with the events or harassing the judges will be asked to leave.**
- No sunflower seeds, popcorn, or gum allowed anywhere on the field, track, or in the stands
- No food allowed on the field
- No awnings, blankets, etc. on the grass
- No playing in the sand pits
- Athletes must report to their events immediately when announced. Failure to do so may result in a missed opportunity to participate in the event. If there is a conflict between events, report to the running event first, and notify the announcer.
